CARBON DIOXIDE CAN CREATE A HAZARDOUS ATMOSPHERE.

CARBON DIOXIDE (CO2) CAN BE USED AS A GAS, LIQUID, OR SOLID (DRY ICE). IN THE GASEOUS STATE IT IS ODORLESS, COLORLESS, AND TASTELESS MAKING IT UNDETECTABLE TO PERSONS IN THE AREA. EVEN WHEN ADEQUATE OXYGEN IS PRESENT, EXPOSURE TO CARBON DIOXIDE CAN LEAD TO CO2 POISONING. AN ASPHYXIATION HAZARD CAN ALSO EXIST. FOLLOW STATE AND LOCAL BUILDING AND FIRE CODES.
